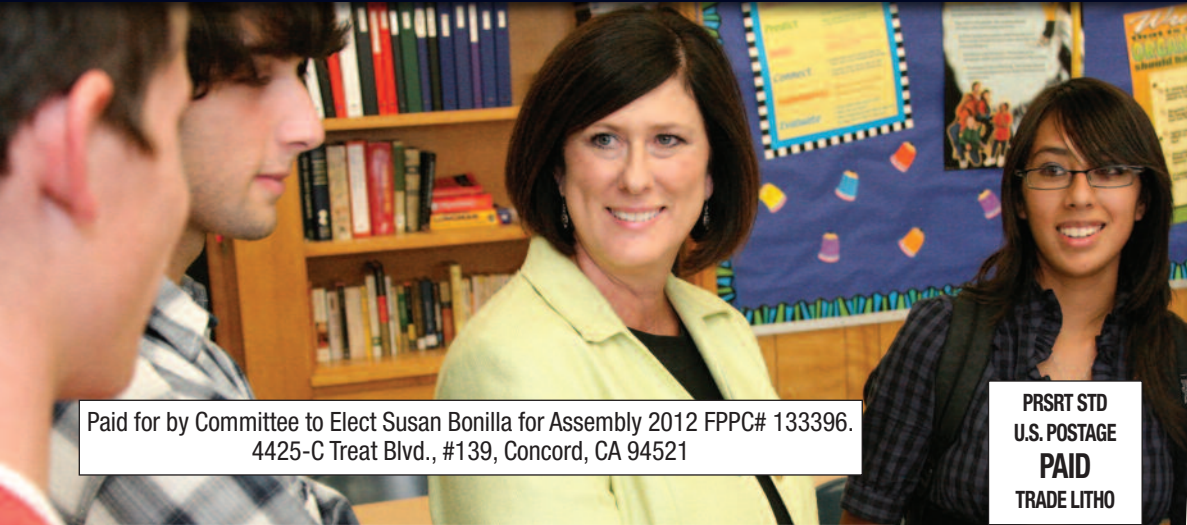

Please join me in supporting Proposition 30.

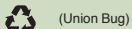
