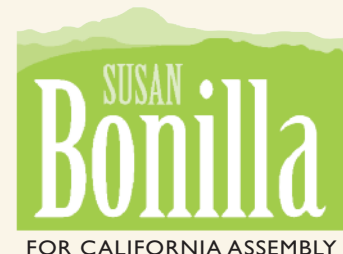

THE SPECIAL EXEMPTIONS ACT ISN'T WHAT IT SEEMS. GET THE FACTS.



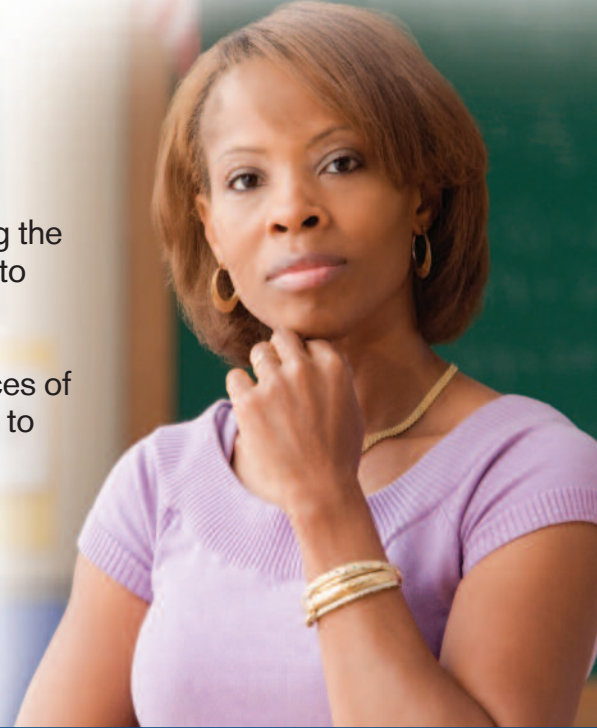
